DWELLING IN THE HEART

In the gospel of Luke, we read of an early story of Jesus' life. When he went with his family, and many others, to Jerusalem for the Passover at age 12, we read of a dilemma that happened.

Instead of going back with the caravan to Nazareth, Jesus remained behind. His parents thinking he was lost panicked! They finally found him a few days later in the Temple. Jesus asks: "Why were you looking for me? Did you not know I must be in my Father's house?" then, when he finally went with them, we read: "that his mother kept all these things in her heart."

Mary is a young mother, her first born son was conceived in an unusual circumstance. She is a confused teenager trying to raise a child who seems to be more knowledgeable than the average child. She and Joseph become parents who make a loving home for her family in the midst of violence and poverty. She becomes a devastated mother who watches her son unjustly tried, condemned, and executed. But through it all Mary continues to seek God's purpose in all this.

We all can identify with Mary as we too have been pierced with sorrow. Coping with a serious illness, watching a loved one die, seeing children make mistakes that seem unsolvable, living with the threat of violence and possible loss of income, all these sorrows are with us today. But like Mary, may we come to know within our own hearts of God's grace and purpose for our lives. With God's grace, as Mary knew in her heart, we will be transformed from our suffering and brokenness into a resurrection, into a new creation. God is dwelling in our hearts as we too witness the challenges of today.

Revised Common Lectionary

The readings used at our weekly worship service and in most Mainline Protestant Churches and in Roman Catholic Churches are from a list of assigned readings known as The New Revised Common Lectionary. In our Congregational tradition, pastors are encouraged to use the assigned readings but it is not mandatory.

I personally prefer to follow the readings and I mainly focus on the Gospel lessons for my meditation. It gives me and you a structure through which we can study and learn from the teachings of the scripture of the Word (Logos) of God in our midst.
